BARISTA

BUILDING SKILLS ONE CUP AT A TIME

Participants will build key barista micro-skills including grinding, dosing, tamping, espresso extraction, milk frothing, pouring, and preparing milkshakes and frappes. They'll also develop important foundational skills like hygiene, time management, multitasking, and customer service. A café excursion will give participants a behind-the-scenes look at realworld coffee service, connecting hands-on learning with industry practice in action. Gaining a recognised Barista Certification.



GIFTWARE

USE YOUR PAWS TO CREATE THE CUTEST GIFTWARE

Our Giftware program builds real-world skills through creative, animal-themed projects. Participants develop fine motor skills, safe tool use, planning and design, and attention to detail—while also building confidence, problem-solving, and teamwork. Each week builds on the last, helping participants gain the skills they need to create, package, price and even promote their own handmade giftware face to face and online.

COOKING

BUILD YOUR COOKING CAPACITY ONE MICRO SKILL AT A TIME

Our Space Cooking program is designed to take participants on a journey through the kitchen, one skill at a time. Each week builds onto the last, covering essential cooking techniques like slicing, dicing, measuring, mixing, and controlling heat on the stove and in the oven. We also focus on safe food handling practices, including proper storage of ingredients and leftovers to keep everyone healthy and confident in the kitchen. Gaining a Food Alert Certificate within the time.
